

## 2 Day 1 Night Camp at River Wonders

### For 2026

#### Synopsis

The River Wonders camp aims to highlight the threats faced by wildlife in freshwater ecosystems and inspire individuals to take responsibility and help protect people, wildlife and the planet.

#### Learning Outcomes

- Global awareness:  
Students will learn about threats that wildlife and people face, Mandai's conservation and sustainability initiatives.
- Inventive thinking, collaboration and communication:  
Students will work together to devise solutions for a conservation challenge and be inspired to protect wildlife.
- Critical thinking:  
Students will synthesise learnings and reflect on their roles as global citizens
